
## **CHILDREN'S BASIC LEARNING COMPETENCIES**

Brief report June 2015

BRAC and IID jointly conducted a survey in order to assess children's basic learning competencies in reading (native language and English) and arithmetic. Simple tests at the household level were conducted for the assessment.

The assessment was done among 791 primary school going children (aged 5 to 15 years) in the rural areas of 2 districts of Sylhet division.

About 50% respondents were selected from the hard to reach areas in the respective districts. This brief report highlights the initial results drawn from the assessment.
